



#### The Holiday Season is Upon Us!

With just three weeks remaining in 2021, we are closing out one of the busiest years in transaction volume in the history of NYC! Our team proudly surpassed our goal this year, and we are on track to triple numbers from last year.

We believe the market bottom was December 2020, which shows how drastic 12 months can change. However, it was also the same month that exhibited a turning point for business. The end of 4th quarter 2020 showed signs of contract volume picking up, coinciding with the vaccine announcement in November 2020.

As Thanksgiving week demonstrated <u>further strength</u> in the real estate markets, it goes to show that there is never really a bad time to list. No longer is the antiquated way of thinking holidays hinder deals getting done.

As more people <u>move into NYC</u> in 2021 than in 2019, they are returning to find an inflated and high rental market that is up 20% since January and 10% between July & October alone! As rental inventory is tight in supply and inflated in price, the sales market remains opportunistic with reasonable prices. This has kept purchasers motivated.

Rates are likely to remain low through 2022, resulting in continued growth for NYC and its rebound. While we feel strongly the market has additional upside, it is worth noting challenges:

• Foreign buyers, while back, are not back at the levels previously seen in 2010-2016. As the dollar hit a new 16 month high, it is still more expensive for foreign buyers. Additionally, the draconian rules that landlords face regarding eviction during Covid are still in place until

early 2022.

• Inflation at a 39 year <u>high</u> will cause operational costs of buildings to increase. Diligent buildings have begun increasing budgets and preparing for higher contracting costs and supply chain issues. Many homeowners can expect higher monthly HOA's in the coming years. There is often a sharp correlation between the value of apartments and monthly carrying costs associated with ownership.


We remain strong and optimistic about the future of NYC real estate, and the expected upside 2022 will bring!
