In Uncertain Times, There's Always Real Estate

Regardless of interest rate swings, stock market declines, and an emergent "crypto winter", there is still a bright space for solid investment growth and returns–and <u>NYC real estate</u> is proving to fit the bill. If this isn't what you've been reading or hearing, pay less mind to the headlines. New York City is not like everywhere else, and the economic factors slowing down housing markets nationwide simply do not apply here. Yes, the markets are soft, but NYC real estate <u>contract volume</u> has been up in recent months, with values somewhat intact. There are buyers, and there are sellers. If properties are priced correctly for the market, deals are happening.

Here are some additional things affecting the markets that you might find interesting to know:

• The Fed, in efforts to tame looming inflation, will continue its <u>interest rate</u> debacle when they meet again in mid-December. After a number of 0.75-point rate hikes, this next one is anticipated to be lower.


- <u>Fifth Avenue is back</u>. In fact, this luxury shopping area has reclaimed its No.1 spot as one of the world's most expensive retail districts, with annual rent averaging \$2,000 per square foot.
- <u>Rentals</u> have come down off their all-time highs, and concessions rose to 11.5 percent in October. Still, potential renters are looking to owning real estate as a better option, especially given this last year's <u>craziness</u>.
- With the stock markets swirling, <u>Wall Street bonuses</u> this year could be down as much as 45% for some employees. While some buyers will be affected by these pullbacks, we believe NYC real estate will remain somewhat unaffected since the buyer base here is so diverse in culture and industry background.
- The <u>conforming loan limit</u> for 2023 has been raised to \$1.089 million.
- NYC is in the middle of a tech boom, and although recent layoffs have forced some restructuring, major companies continue to expand here <u>despite their fiscal woes</u>. Google, Amazon, and Apple are securing over 3.1 million square feet of space for <u>incoming</u> <u>employees</u>, and this growth has many tech professionals on the lookout for luxury condo living space in the city.
- Cryptocurrency exchange FTX shook the crypto sector when it filed for bankruptcy in November after a pullback from Binance and a rush of customer withdrawals. While this event is further prompting federal regulation, it's likely not going to halt innovation and change. Still, we feel events like these point more and more to where the safer asset classes are right now, and real estate is one of them.

As the year winds down, we feel that while the economy may be volatile for a while, diversification into real estate can be a good way to ride out the storm.


