The Market is Moving, Especially in Luxury Real Estate

As we move through the spring real estate market, several things are evident: the <u>luxury market</u> is strong, there's still limited home inventory available, and competition for homes is steady. This is all happening despite persistent inflation, slowing GDP growth, and concern that the Federal Reserve may table <u>interest rate cuts</u> through 2024.

While higher interest rates may be keeping some from entering the NYC real estate market, these rates may be prompting others to accept where things are and move forward making the best decisions they can considering the time period. For a seller, this means patience and pricing right in the market may help achieve a more favorable outcome. For a buyer, this means being opportunistic and purchasing that just-right place before prices push higher may just save them from the infamous "buyer's remorse."

Some things to know:

- Nationwide, <u>luxury real estate sales increased</u> more than 2% in the first quarter of 2024, the highest year-over-year increase in three years. In Manhattan, 68% of first quarter luxury sales were all-cash deals.
- The <u>median asking price</u> for a NYC home was \$1.1 million in March, which was 10.4% higher than the same time period in 2023.

- Homes entering contract in March that were <u>priced 1.5% below</u> average neighborhood list prices spent only 58 days on the market versus a median of 161 days.
- <u>Median rental prices</u> in Manhattan have been lower overall but still 14.2% higher than pre-pandemic rents.

Looking ahead to summer, we expect demand for rentals to increase as usual and demand for homes to keep the market competitive. In conclusion, working with <u>an experienced area broker</u> will not only be less cumbersome for all involved, but it will ensure that the best price gets negotiated.



Monthly Closed Sales




